

FROM DEATH TO LIFE

As he thundered down the road, Saul pondered the wonders of the Roman Empire. It was the largest empire the world had ever seen, and it brought near strange, new people, languages, and customs from faraway places. The cobblestone road he was riding on was a marvel itself. There were 29 great military highways that radiated from the capital – able to move the armies of the empire where they needed to go quickly. There were also 372 great roads that connected the empire’s 113 provinces. Roads were one of the three great public responsibilities of the empire (the other two were aqueducts and sewers). Roman roads were often straight and to the point, helping travelers get to where they needed to go. In the Bible, there is a series of verses called The Romans Road. Found in the Letter to the Romans, they get right to the point of salvation –they tell us what we need to know. A jailer once asked, “What must I do to be saved?” The Romans Road answers his question.
