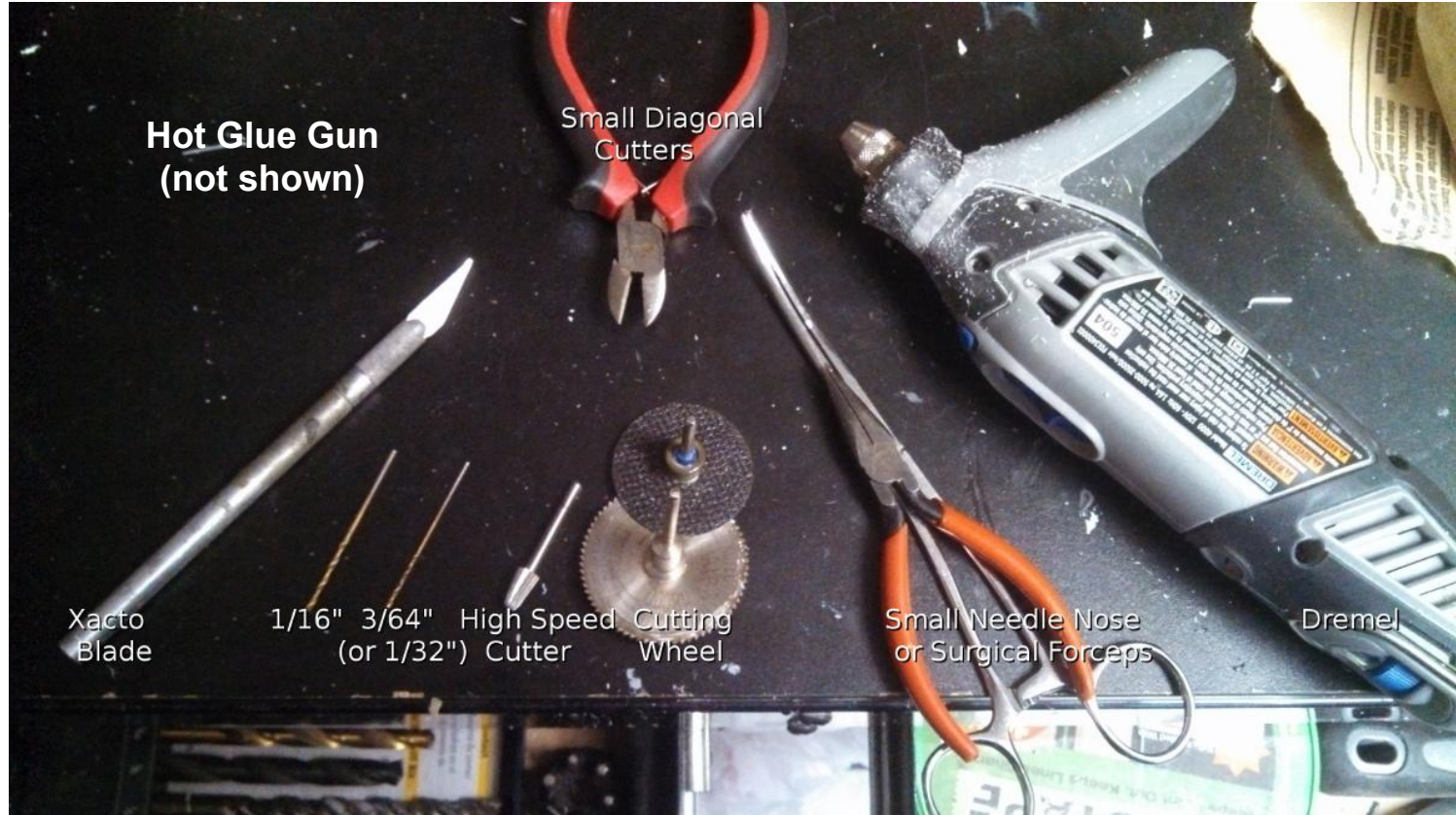

Skull Jaw Mods

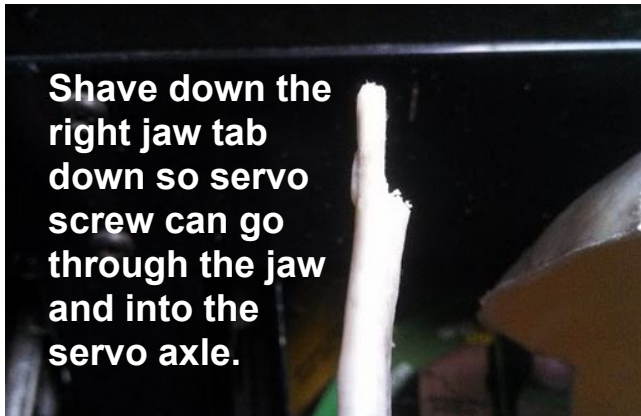
Cut Out Back of Skull



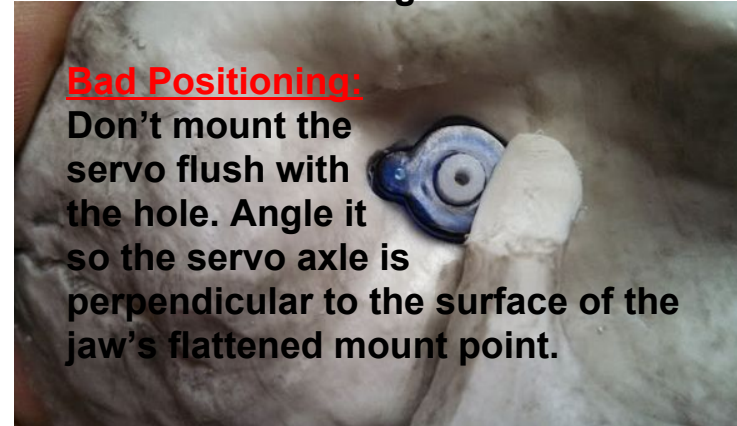
Remove Jaw's Right Tab



Shave/Flatten Jaw Tab



Drill Out Right Jaw Hole

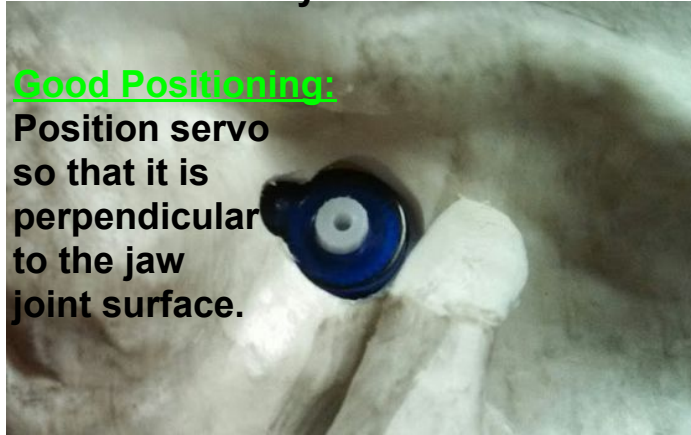


Skull Jaw Mods

Correctly Position Servo

Good Positioning:

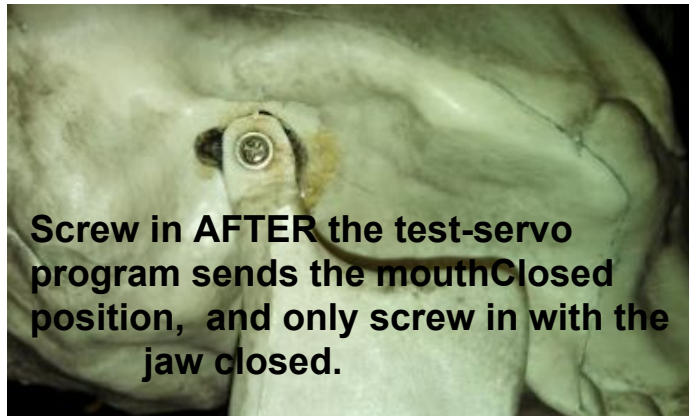
Position servo so that it is perpendicular to the jaw joint surface.



Glue & Mount Servo



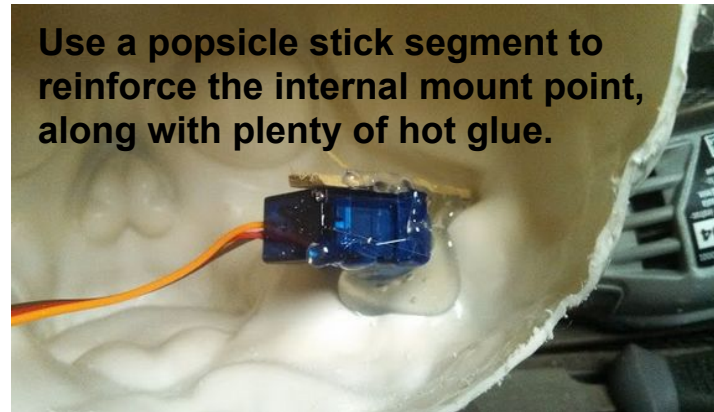
Drill 1/32 Screw Hole & Mount Jaw



Screw in AFTER the test-servo program sends the mouthClosed position, and only screw in with the jaw closed.

Structural Hot Gluing Internally

Use a popsicle stick segment to reinforce the internal mount point, along with plenty of hot glue.

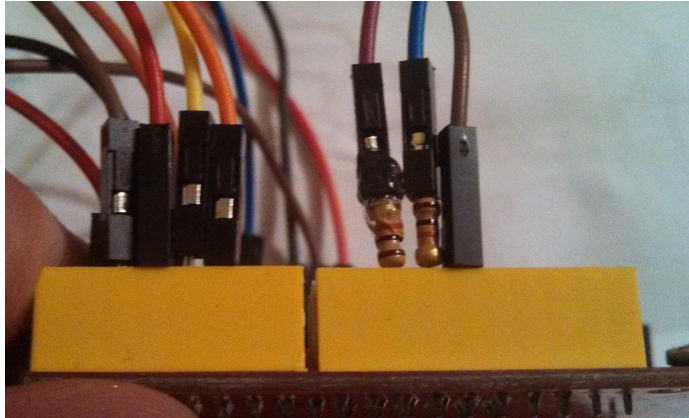


Inline Resistors

1k Resistors for MP3 TX/RX Lines

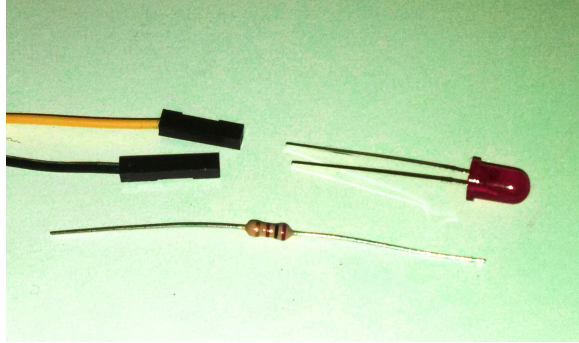


MP3 TX/RX Lines Mounted(10&11)

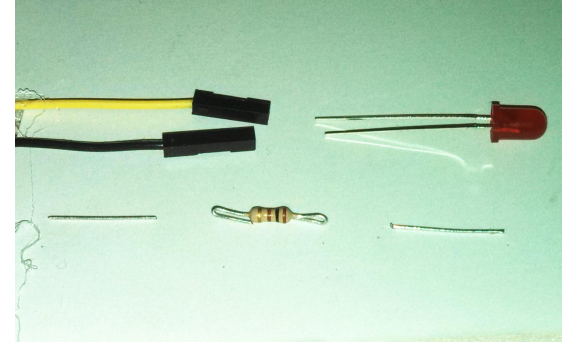


LED Eyes

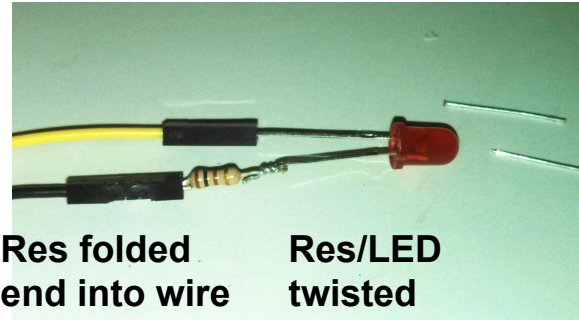
100ohm LED Eye Resistors



Trim & Fold Resistor LED Leads



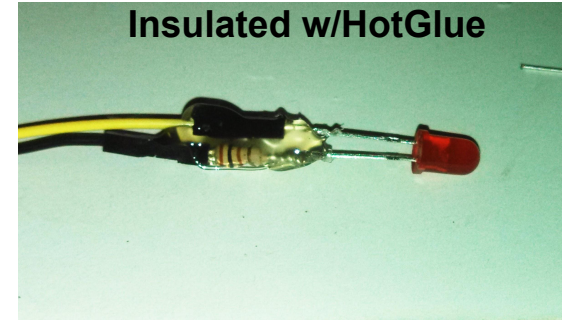
Insert Resistor & LED Into F Wire

end into wire

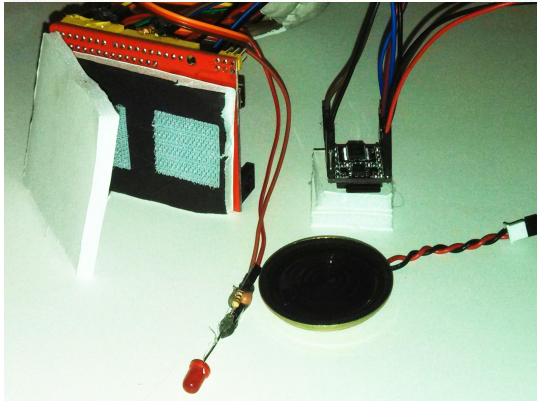
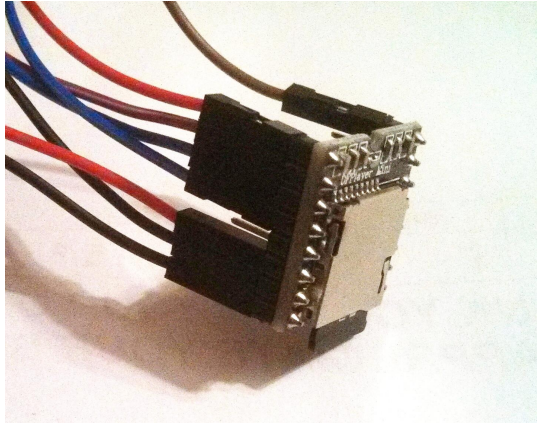
Res/LED
