Over 181 companies are located in are area, ranging from local startups to cloud-computing giant Rackspace Hosting. IT and software companies can be found throughout Montgomery County, but the majority of them are clustered in the Virginia Tech Corporate Research Center and downtown Blacksburg.

Montgomery County offers businesses in the IT and software industry many advantages including access to top tier talent from Virginia Tech and Radford University, gigabit broadband access, a cost of doing business far less than larger metros, and a quality of life that enable companies to attract and retain talent.

The Virginia Tech Corporate Research Center is a 230-acre research park with over 1 million square feet of Class A office space. The park is home to over 160 technology companies and was named the No. 1 Research Park in North America in 2010 by the Association of University Research Parks.

The graph above provides a compelling visual of how much money a softwarerelated company can save by locating in Montgomery County. Each bar shows how much more expensive a 100-person, 10,000 square-foot (100 square feet per person) software development office is in each city, based on software developer salaries and office space. Compared to Blacksburg, a 100-person software development center costs \$1.6 million more annually in Raleigh-Durham and \$4.8 million annually in Silicon Valley. It's simple, we can save you money.
